

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND
PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at St Julian's, the directum dominium of which belongs to the Government.

Since the said plot of land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The plot of land in question is required by the Government for the erection of an Electricity Sub-Station; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the value of the temporary utile dominium of the plot of land in question amounts to £24.2s.6d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Saint Julian's:-

A plot of land of the area of 9.65 square canes, bounded on the North and on the East by Government property held on temporary emphyteusis by the Spinola Development Company Limited and on the South by Spinola Road; it is the property of the Government of Malta as regards the Directum Dominium and the property of the Spinola Development Company Limited as regards the temporary Utile Dominium.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 133/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
