

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Hamrun.

Since the said plots of land are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The two plots of land in question are required by the Government in connection with the extension of the Office Block at the Milk Marketing Undertaking, they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above two plots of land amounts to £175.10s. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Hamrun:

1. A plot of land of the area of 142 square canes, bounded on the East by property of St George's Parish Church, Qormi, on the South by Government property and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Eucaristo Bajada.

2. A plot of land of the area of 83.75 square canes, bounded on the West by property of Mr Eucaristo Bajada, on the South and on the East by Government property and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of St George's Parish Church, Qormi.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 142/67 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
