

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND
PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a garage and a dwelling house at Victoria, Gozo.

Since the said premises are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

These premises are required by the Government in connection with road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above garage and of the above dwelling house amounts to £520.0.0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Victoria-Gozo:

1. Garage at Nos. 28, 29, Monsignor Luigi Vella Street; it is the property of Mr. Salvu Vella.
2. Premises at No. 30, Monsignor Luigi Vella Street, corner with Nos, 1, 2, Assumption Street; it is the property of Mr. Francis Agius.

The above-mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 190/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
