

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND
PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at Luqa.

Since the land in question is permanently required, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said plot of land is required by the Government in connection with industrial development; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the land in question amounts to £1,335. Os. 6d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Luqa:

A plot of land of the area of 9 Tumoli and 2 Sieghan, bounded on the North by a public road and on the East and South by Government property; it is the property of the Archiepiscopal Curia.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 65/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
