

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY  
AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance(Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of premises No.1 at Ghosts Street, Hamrun.

Since the said premises are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The premises in question are required by the Government for the purpose of road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above premises amounts to £1,110.0s. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Hamrun:

Premises No.1. Ghosts Street having two other unnumbered entrances, one on Ghosts Street and one on St Luke's Road; it is the property of Miss Mary Mintoff and others as regards the perpetual utile dominium and of Mr Anthony Seguna as regards the directum dominium.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D.219/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
