

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of seven plots of land at "Ta' Grixti", in the limits of Marsa.

Since the said plots of land are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government in connection with the extension of the Marsa Industrial Estate; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above seven plots of land amounts to £5391. Os. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at "Ta' Grixti", limits of Marsa:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 3 Tumoli, 3 Sieghan and 6 Kejllet, bounded on the North-East by a road, on the South-West by property of Mr Joseph Mifsud and on the West by property of Mrs Anna Mifsud; it is the property of Mr Carmelo Fenech A. & C.E. and others.
2. A plot of land of the area of 2 Tumoli and 7 Kejllet, bounded on the North-East by a road, on the South by property of Dr George Schembri LL.D. and others and on the North-West and North by property of Mr Carmelo Fenech A.&. C.E. and others; it is the property of Mr. Alfred Naudi.
3. A plot of land of the area of 5 Tumoli, 4 Sieghan and 5.6 Kejllet, bounded on the East by a road, on the North-West by property of Mr Joseph Mifsud and on the North by property of Mr. Alfred Naudi; it is the property of Dr George Schembri LL.D. and others.
4. A plot of land of the area of 11 Tumoli, 5 Sieghan and 3 Kejllet, bounded on the North-West partly by property of Mr Joseph Mifsud and partly by Government property, on the East by a road and on the North-East by property of Dr George Schembri LL.D. and others; it is the property of Dr Leslie Grech and others.
5. A plot of land of the area of 6 Tumoli, 3 Sieghan and 7 Kejllet, bounded on the North-East by property of Mr Carmelo Fenech A. & C.E. and others, on the South-East partly by property of Dr George Schembri LL.D. and others, and partly by property of Dr Leslie Grech and others, and on the North-West by property of Marquis Scicluna; it is the property of Mr. Joseph Mifsud.
6. A plot of land of the area of 11 Tumoli, 4 Sieghan

and 4 Kejllet, bounded on the South-East partly by property of Mr Joseph Mifsud and partly by Government property, on the West by Government property and on the North-East by property of Mrs. Anna Mifsud; it is the property of Scicluna's Estate.

7. A plot of land of the area of 1 Tumolo, 5 Sieghan and 4 Kejllet, bounded on the East by property of Mr Carmelo Fenech A. & C.E. and others, and on the South-West and West by property of Scicluna's Estate; it is the property of Mrs. Anna Mifsud.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 186/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
