MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFIARS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at St. Paul's Bay.

Since the said two plots are permanently required Oby the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The plots of land in question are required by the Government in connection with road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above two Transpires that the total freehold plots of land amounts to £10,950.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Rdum Rxaw, Xemxija Hill, St. Paul's Bay.

- 1. A plot of land of the area of 1 Tumolo, 2 Sieghan and 2.2. Kejliet, bounded on the South-West by a Street, on the South-East by property of Mrs. Felicia Cremona and others, and on the North-East, North and North-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Joseph G. Coleiro and others.
- 2. A plot of land of the area od 4 Sieghan and 3 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West by property of Mr Joseph G. Coleiro and others, on the West and South-West by a street, and on the South-East partly by the foreshore and partly by the remaining portion of the land of which this plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs. Felicia Cremona and others.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 449/66, which may be seen on deman at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
