

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY  
AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached draft Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of seven plots of land in the limits of Zejtun and Marsaxlokk.

Since the land in question is permanently required by the Government it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government in connection with the widening of Marsaxlokk Road; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the seven plots of land in question amounts to £1,086..0s.0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

## DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

### Description of the Land

The following land in the Limits of Zejtun and Marsaxlokk:

1. A plot of land of the area of 2 sieghan and 1.3 kejllet bounded on the West by property of the Noble Misses Carmelina and Theresa Trapani Galea and others, on the South West by Marnisi Road, and on the North East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Astra Development Company Malta Limited.
2. A plot of land of the area of 2 tmien and 8.4 kejllet which includes part of a farmhouse and other rural structures thereon, bounded on the South West by Marnisi Road, on the East by property of the Astra Development Company Malta Limited, and on the North East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Noble Misses Carmelina and Theresa Trapani Galea and others.
3. A plot of land of the area of 4.2 kejllet bounded on the North East and West by Marnisi Road, and on the South West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Estate of the late Marquis James Cassar Desain and others.
4. A plot of land of the area of 7.7 kejllet, bounded on the East by Marnisi Road, on the North West by property of Mr Anthony Tabone, and on the South West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Consiglio Tabone.
5. A plot of land of the area of 2 sieghan and 5 kejllet, bounded on the South East by property of Mr Consiglio Tabone, on the North West by property of Saint Lawrence Parish Church of Vittoriosa, and on the South West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Anthony Tabone.
6. A plot of land of the area of 2 sieghan and 1 kejllet, bounded on the North by Marnisi Road, on the South East by property of Mr Anthony Tabone, and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Saint Lawrence Parish Church of Vittoriosa.
7. A plot of land of the area of 2 kejllet, bounded on the South East by property of Saint Lawrence Parish Church of Vittoriosa, on the North by Marnisi Road, and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Carmel Fenech.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 238/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
