

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of 6 plots of land at Gormi.

Since the land in question is permanently required by the Government it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above land is required by the Government in connection with the erection of a Pitkali Central Market; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above six plots of land amounts to £15,435.12s. 2d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Ġormi:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 6 tmien, 3 sieghan and 3.5 kejljet, bounded on the North by property of the Legacy Chierico Paolo Xuereb and sisters attached to St George's Parish Church of Ġormi, on the East by a public road, and on the West by property of Mr John Camilleri; it is the property of the heirs of the late Sir Luigi Preziosi.
2. A plot of land of the area of 4 tmien, 4 sieghan and 2 kejljet, bounded on the East by a public road, on the West by property of Mr John Camilleri, and on the South by property of the heirs of the late Sir Luigi Preziosi; it is the property of the legacy Chierico Paolo Xuereb and sisters attached to St George's Church of Ġormi.
3. A plot of land of the area of 5 tmien, bounded on the East partly by property of the Legacy Chierico Paolo Xuereb attached to St George's Parish Church of Ġormi and partly by property of the heirs of the late Sir Luigi Preziosi, on the West partly by property of St George's Parish Church of Ġormi and partly by a lane, and on the South by a lane; it is the property of Mr John Camilleri.
4. A plot of land of the area of 5 tmien and 2.4 kejljet which includes a farmhouse, bounded on the East by property of Mr John Camilleri, on the West by property of Messrs Orland Brothers and on the South by property of Mr John Camilleri; it is the property of St George's Parish Church of Ġormi.
5. A plot of land of the area of 2 tmien and 5 kejljet, bounded on the North by property of St George's Parish Church of Ġormi, on the West by property of Messrs Orland Brothers, and on the East by a lane; it is the property of Mr John Camilleri.
6. A plot of land of the area of 6 tmien, 3 sieghan and 7 kejljet, bounded on the East partly by property of St George's Parish Church of Ġormi and partly by property of Mr John Camilleri, on the West by a lane, and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Messrs Orland Brothers.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 204/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
