

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of three plots of land at Fgura.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The said plots of land are required by the Government in connection with the construction of a Car Park; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above three plots of land amounts to £215.16.8d.

The attached Declaration is to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 198 dated 23rd March, 1967.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Fgura:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 1 Tomna, 5 Sieghan and 6.5 Kejllet, bounded on the South partly by White Friars Street, partly by property of the Carmelite Friars of Fgura, partly by property of Mr. Joseph Tanti and partly by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part, and on the North and East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Salvatore Gauci Chapelle and others.
2. A plot of land of the area of 2 Kejllet, bounded on the North by property of Mr. Salvatore Gauci Chapelle and others, on the East by property of Mr. Joseph Tanti and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Carmelite Friars of Fgura.
3. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 1 Kejla, bounded on the North by property of Mr. Salvatore Gauci Chapelle and other, on the West by property of the Carmelite Friars of Fgura and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Joseph Tanti.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 366A/66 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.

This declaration is to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 198 of the 23rd March, 1967.
