

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY  
AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two premises at Pietà.

Since the above premises are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The two premises in question are required by the Government in connection with the opening of an access road to Pietà School; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above two premises amounts to £750. 0s. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Pieta':

1. Premises No.6, Alley 2, Pieta Wharf, Pieta'; property of St Catherine's Monastery.
2. Premises No.7, Alley 2, Pieta Wharf, Pieta'; property of St Catherine's Monastery.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 7/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
