

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a part of the garden at No. 26, St. Mary Street, Safi.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

This land is required by the Government in connection with road widening; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the said land amounts to £306.5.0d.

This declaration is intended to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 614 of the 9th November, 1955.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Safi:

Part of garden at No. 26 Saint Mary Street, of the area of 49 square canes, bounded on the West-North-West by Church Square, on the East-South-East and on the South-South-West by Saint Mary Street, and on the North-North-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Emanuel Busuttill.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 30/68 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.

This declaration is to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 614 dated 9th November, 1955.
