

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of three plots of land at Bugibba, in the limits of St. Paul's Bay.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The land in question is required by the Government in connection with the formation of a new road; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above three plots of land amounts to £2018. 0. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Bugibba limits of Saint Paul's Bay.

1. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 6 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West by property of Mr. Carmelo Petroni, and on the South-West and South-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Notary Joseph Gatt and others.
2. A plot of land of the area of 3 Sieghan and 3.87 Kejliet bounded on the South-East partly by property of Notary Joseph Gatt and others, and partly by property of Mr. Angelo Ciappara and others, on the North by property of Mr. Carmelo Petroni and others, and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Carmelo Petroni.
3. A plot of land of the area of 9.3. Kejliet, bounded on the South by property of Mr. Carmelo Petroni, on the North-East and North-West by an alley,

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and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Carmelo Petroni and others.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 285/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
