

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY
AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of 2 plots of land at Qorni.

Since these plots are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The land in question is required by the Government for the purpose of road widening; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above two plots of land amounts to £150. 0s. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Qorni:-

1. Part of a room at ground floor level at premises No. 203, Victory Street, of the area of 1.2 square canes, bounded on the West by Anici Street, on the South by Victory Street and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Miss Carmen Azzopardi.
2. Part of premises No. 204, Victory Street, consisting of part of a room at ground floor level of the area of 2.6 square canes, and part of a yard of the area of 1.4 square canes including part of a room of the area of 14 square feet, bounded on the West by Anici Street, on the South by room No.203, Victory Street, and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Miss Carmen Azzopardi.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 208/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
