

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of 5 premises at Zurrieq.

Since the said premises are permanently required by the Government it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The above premises are required by the Government in connection with the opening of a new street from Queen Street to Zurrieq Square, Zurrieq; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of all the above premises amounts to £3,400. 0. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Zurrieg:--

1. Premises No. 7, Saint Nicholas Street, corner with No. 65, Queen Street; they are the property of Mrs. Caterina Cassar.
2. Shop No. 8, Saint Nicholas Street; it is the property of Mrs. Caterina Cassar.
3. Premises No 66, Queen Street; they are the property of the Parish Church of Zurrieg as regards the Directum Dominium and of Mr. Rokku Griscti as regards the temporary Utile Dominium.
4. Premises No. 67, Queen Street; they are the property of the Parish Church of Zurrieg as regards the Directum Dominium and of Mr. Rokku Griscti as regards the temporary Utile Dominium.
5. Premises No. 68, Queen Street; they are the property of Mr. Francis Schembri.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 125/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
