

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY
AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Kerċem, Gozo.

Since the said plots are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The land in question is required by the Government in connection with the widening of St. Peter and St. Paul Street, Kerċem; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above two plots of land amounts to \$152. 0. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Kerċem, Gozo:

1. A plot of land of the area of 9.6 square canes bounded on the North-East by Saint Peter and Saint Paul Street, on the South-East by property of Messrs. George and Saviour Cassar, and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Saint Catherine's Monastery of Valletta.
2. A plot of land of the area of 14.7 square canes bounded on the North-East by Saint Peter and Saint Paul Street, on the South-East by Sarc Street, on the North-West by property of Saint Catherine's Monastery of Valletta, and on the South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Messrs. George and Saviour Cassar.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 266/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
