

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND

PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory Acquisition of eight plots of land at Zurrieq.

Since the said land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government in connection with the widening of Valletta Road, Zurrieq; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the eight plots of land in question amounts to £423. 3. 4.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Zurrieg:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 1.6 Kejliet, bounded on the West-North-West by Valletta Road, on the South-South-West by property of Mr. Zareno Cassar and on the East-South-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Francis Saydon.
2. A plot of land of the area of 6.6 Kejliet, bounded on the West by Valletta Road, on the South by property of the Most Noble Marquis Alfio Testaferrata Bonici Ghaxaq, and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Zarenu Cassar.
3. A plot of land of the area of 2 Sieghan and 7.6 Kejliet, bounded on the West and South by Valletta Road, and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Most Noble Marquis Alfio Testaferrata Bonice Ghaxaq.
4. A plot of land of the area of 5 Sieghan and 6.8 Kejliet, bounded on the East and North-North-East by Valletta Road, and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Augustinian Fathers of Valletta.
5. A plot of land of the area of 8.3 Kejliet, bounded on the West by Valletta Road, on the South by property of Mr. Toni Bajjada, and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Toni Schembri.
6. A plot of land of the area of 3 Sieghan and 9.8 Kejliet, bounded on the West-North-West by Valletta Road, on the South-South-West by property of the Archiepiscopal Curia, and on the East-South-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Toni Bajjada.

7. A plot of land of the area of 1 Tmien, bounded on the West-North-West by Valletta Road, on the North-North-East by property of Mr. Toni Bajjada, and on the East-South-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Archiepiscopal Curia.

8. A plot of land of the area of 3.5 Kejllet, bounded on the West-North-West by Valletta Road, on the North-North-East by a lane and on the East-South-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Cathedral Chapter of Mdina.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 227/67, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
