

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Luqa Road, Paola.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for the purpose of road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £5,122. 10. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Luqa Road, Paola:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 245 square canes, bounded on the North, South-East and East by Luqa Road, and on the West partly by property of Mr. Charles Zammit Endrich and partly by property of Mr. Vincent Falzon; it is the property of the Parish Church of Tarxien.

2. A plot of land of the area of 4.8 square canes, bounded on the North by property of the Parish Church of Tarxien, on the East by Luqa Road and on the West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of unknown and uncertain owners.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked LD 305/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
