

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor General refers to the compulsory acquisition of four plots of land at Marsa.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government in connection with the prolongation of a New Street joining Isouard Street with Qormi Road, Marsa; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £537. 0. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Marsa:

1. Part of premises without number in New Street, consisting of small room, part of one yard and part of another yard, and part of a large room of the area of 7.5 square canes at ground floor level and the overlying air space, bounded on the North-East by property of Mrs. Carmela Muscat on the South-East by a road, and on the West by the remaining part of the premises of which it forms part; it is the property of Mr. Carmelo Buhagiar.

2. Part of premises without number in New Street, consisting of a front yard, two rooms and part of another room, of the area of 12.6 square canes at ground floor level and the overlying air space, bounded on the South-East partly by a road and partly by property of Mr. Carmelo Buhagiar, on the South-West and North-East by property of Mr. Carmelo Buhagiar and on the West by the remaining part of the premises of which it forms part; it is the property of Mrs. Carmela Muscat.

3. Part of premises without number in New Street, accessible through the front yard of premises mentioned in item 2, consisting of part of the front yard, 2 rooms and part of the backyard of the area of 15.9 square canes at ground floor level and the overlying air space, bounded on the South-West by property of Mrs. Carmela Muscat, on the North-East by a road and on the West and East by the remaining part of the premises of which it forms part; it is the property of Mr. Carmelo Buhagiar.

4. Part of premises No. 249, Qormi Road, consisting of part of a small room of the area of 0.64 square canes at ground floor level and the overlying air space, bounded on the North-East by a road, on the South-East by property of Mr. Carmelo Buhagiar and on the West by the remaining part of the premises of which it forms part; it is the property of Mr. Carmelo Buhagiar.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 18/69, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
