

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of one plot of land at Rabat, Malta.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plot of land is required by the Government in connection with the Housing Scheme for Rabat; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £16,477. 0. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Rabat, Malta:-

A plot of land of the area of 15 Tumoli, 1 Siegh and 3.8 Kejllet, including the rural structures thereon, bounded on the East and on the West by a lane and on the South by Bir ir-Riebu street; it is the property of the Most Noble Marquis Alfio Testaferrata Bonnici Ghaxaq.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 112/69 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
