

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of seven plots of land at Zurrieq.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government in connection with a proposed playing field; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £1051. 3. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Zurrieg:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 6.5 Kejliet, bounded on the North-East by property of Miss Mary Farrugia and others, on the South-East by property of Mr. John Cassar, and on the South-West by property of Miss Mary Farrugia and others.
2. A plot of land of the area of 7 Kejliet, bounded on the East and North-West by property of Miss Mary Farrugia and others, and on the South-West by property of Mr. John Cassar.
3. A plot of land of the area of 2 Tmien and 4.2 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property of Miss Mary Farrugia and others, on the South by property of Mr. John Cassar, and on the East by property of Mrs. Josephine Gauci.
4. A plot of land of the area of 1 Tomna and 4.6 Kejliet, bounded on the North and East by property of Mrs. Josephine Gauci, on the West by property of Miss Mary Farrugia and others, and on the South-West by property of Mr. John Cassar.
5. A plot of land of the area of 1 Tomna, 3 Sieghan and 2.8 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property of Miss Mary Farrugia and others, on the South partly by property of Mr. John Cassar and partly by property of Miss Mary Farrugia and others, and on the North-East by property of Mrs. Josephine Gauci.
6. A plot of land of the area of 4 Sieghan and 0.9 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property of Mr. John Cassar, on the South by property of Miss Mary Farrugia and others, and on the North-East by property of Mr. John Cassar.
7. A plot of land of the area of 0.7 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West by property of Mr. John

Cassar, and on the South and East by property of Miss Catherine Micallef.
