

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of three plots of land at San Gwann.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for a Housing Scheme; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £8952. Os. Od.

The said Declaration is intended to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 748 on the 16th September, 1969, in so far as item No. 7 is concerned.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land  
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The following land at San Gwann:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 2 Tumoli, 5 Sieghan and 3.88 Kejllet, bounded on the North-West by an alley, on the West by property of Commander David Cox, on the North partly by property of Commander David Cox and partly by a road and on the South-East by property of Mr. Joseph Farrugia.
2. A plot of land of the area of 6.48 Kejllet, bounded on the North-West by an alley, on the North-East by property of Mr. Carmelo Cauchi and on the South-West by property of Mrs. Margherita Buhajjar.
3. A plot of land of the area of 5.94 Kejllet, bounded on the North and West by an alley and on the North-East by property of Mr. Vincent Camilleri.

The above mentioned land is shown as Plots 7A, 7B, and 7C on a plan marked L.D. 87/70 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.

This declaration is to supersede that published by Notice No. 748 dated 16th September, 1969, in so far as item No. 7 is concerned.
