

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of ten plots of land at Xaghra, Gozo.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for the formation of a road linking Xaghra Road to Victory Square, they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £253.6.9.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

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Description of the land  
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The following land at Xaghra, Gozo:

1. A plot of land of the area of 30 square canes, bounded on the North partly by property of Mr. Lorenzo Berg and partly by property of Mr. Angelo Attard, on the South by property of Mr. Francis Azzopardi, and on the West by property of Maria Antonia Portelli.
2. A plot of land of the area of 14.5 square canes; bounded on the North by property of Mr. Vincent Sultana and others, on the East by property of Mr. Salvatore Rapa, and on the South by property of Mr. Francis Azzopardi.
3. A plot of land of the area of 5 square canes, bounded on the North by property of Mr. Casimiro Sultana, on the South by property of Mr. Salvatore Rapa, and on the South-West by property of Mr. Lorenzo Berg.
4. A plot of land of the area of 23.7 square canes, bounded on the North-West by property of Mr. Salvatore Bajada, on the South by property of Mr. Salvatore Rapa, and on the South-West by property of Mr. Vincent Sultana.
5. A plot of land of the area of 9 square canes, bounded on the North-East by property of Mr. Lorenzo Berg, on the South by property of Maria Antonia Portelli, and on the West by property of Mr. Vincent Sultana and others.
6. A plot of land of the area of 12 square canes, bounded on the West by property of M. Michael Bajada, on the South by property of M. Lorenzo Borg, and on the North-East by property of Mr. Casimiro Sultana.
7. A plot of land of the area of 77 square canes, bounded on the South by property of Mr. Argelo Attard, on the South-West partly by property of Mr. Lorenzo Berg and partly by property of Mr. Salvatore Bajada, and on the East by property of Mr. Casimiro Sultana.
8. A plot of land of the area of 6 square canes, bounded on the East partly by property of Mr. Joseph Sultana and partly by property of Mr. Casimiro Sultana, on the South by property of Mr. Salvatore Bajada, and on the West by property of Mr. Michael Bajada.

9. A plot of land of the area of 71.4 square canes, bounded on the North partly by property of Mammente Azzopardi and partly by property of Grazia Camilleri and others, on the South-East by property of Mr. Anthony Farrugia, and on the South partly by property of Mr. Casiniro Sultana, and partly by property of Mr. Joseph Sultana.

10. A plot of land of the area of 13 square canes, bounded on the South by property of Mr. Casiniro Sultana, on the West by property of Grazia Camilleri and others, and on the East by property of Mr. Anthony Farrugia.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 25/70 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office 29, South Street, Valletta.
