

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of premises Nos. 13,14 and 15, St. Francis Street, corner with Mill Street and Saint Paul Street, Qornji.

Since these premises are permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire them by absolute purchase.

The above premises are required by the Government for the opening of Qornji Valley Access Road; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above premises amounts to £4,000.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Qormi:

Premises Nos. 13, 14 and 15, St. Francis Street, corner with Mill Street and Saint Paul Street.
