

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of 12 plots of land at Safi.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for road widening they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £2138. 13. -.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Safi:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 3 Sieghan and 4.5 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West by property of Mr. Walter Ellul Bonnici, on the South-West by Saint John Street, and on the South and South-East by Hal Far Road.
2. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 0.7 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West and East by Hal Far Road, and on the South-East by property of Mr. Michael Angelo Axiaq.
3. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 8.0 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West and North by Hal Far Road, and on the South-East by property of Mrs. Grazia Zammit.
4. A plot of land of the area of 5.8 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property of Mr. Benedict Grech, and on the South by Hal Far Road, and on the North-East by property of the Chapter of Senglea.
5. A plot of land of the area of 2 Sieghan and 0.7 Kejliet, bounded on the North and East by property of the Chapter of Senglea, on the South and South-East by Hal Far Road, and on the South-West by property of Mr. Benedict Grech.
6. A plot of land of the area of 9.5 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West and East by Hal Far Road, and on the South-East and West by property of Mr. Paul Zammit.
7. A plot of land of the area of 5.1 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West by property of Mrs. Helen Callus, and on the South and South-East by Hal Far Road.
8. A plot of land of the area of 7.7 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West and West by Hal Far Road, and on the South-East by property of Senglea Parish Church.
9. A plot of land of the area of 6.9 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West by property of Mr. Joseph Caruana and on the South and South-East by Hal Far Road.

10. A plot of land of the area of 4.2 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West and North by Hal Far Road, and on the South-East by property of Senglea Parish Church.

11. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 0.3 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West by property of Mr. George Cachia, and on the South and South-East by Hal Far Road.

12. A plot of land of the area of 6 Kejliet, bounded on the North-North-West and North-East by Hal Far Road, and on the South by property of Senglea Parish Church.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 326/69, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
