

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of three plots of land at Zabbar.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for the erection of a Market Place; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £2244. 13. 0.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Zebbar:

1. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 3.8 Kejljet, bounded on the North-West and South-West by property of Mr. Angelo Scicluna, on the North by property of Mr. Michael Gatt, and on the South-East by property of Saint Scholastica's Monastery of Vittoriosa.
2. A plot of land of the area of 2.8 Kejljet, bounded on the North-West and East by property of Mr. Michael Gatt, on the South by property of Mr. Angelo Scicluna, and on the South-East by property of Saint Scholastica's Monastery of Vittoriosa.
3. A plot of land of the area of 4 Sieghan and 5.7 Kejljet, bounded on the North-West partly by property of Mr. Angelo Scicluna and partly by property of Mr. Michael Gatt, on the South-West and North-East by property of Saint Scholastica's Monastery of Vittoriosa, and on the South-East by a public road.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 317/69, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
