

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of premises Nos. 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59, 60 and 61 at Church Wharf, Marsa.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above premises are required by the Government for the extension of the Malta Power/Water station; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires the total freehold value of the above premises amounts to £11,000. 0. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL
