

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Hondoq ir-Runnien, limits of Qala, Gozo.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for use as a hard stone quarry in connection with the Mgarr Harbour Project; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £12,586. 12. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR--GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Kondoq ir-Runnien limits of Gela, Gozo:--

1. A plot of land of the area of 50 Tunoli, 2 Siegħan and 1.7 Kejliet including the rural structures thereon, bounded on the North by property of Mr. Salvatore Camilleri, on the West partly by a road and partly by property in course of acquisition by Government and on the South by the foreshore.
2. A plot of land of the area of 10 Tunoli, 2 Siegħan and 3.6 Kejliet, bounded on the North-East and West by a road and on the South by property of the Augustinian Fathers of Victoria, Gozo.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 21/70 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
