

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of five plots of land at Zebbug, Malta.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for a Housing scheme; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £1,340. 17. 6d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Zebbug, Malta:

1. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 2.4 Kejliet, bounded on the North-East by property of Mr. Crazio Fenech, on the West by Mill Street, on the East by property of Mr. Carmel Mifsud, and on the South by property of Mr. Crazio Fenech.
2. A plot of land of the area of 2 Sieghan, bounded on the North, East and West by property of Mr. Carmel Mifsud, and on the South-West by property of Zebbug Parish Church.
3. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh, bounded on the North-East by property of Mr. Carmel Mifsud, on the East and West by property of Zebbug Parish Church, and on the South-East by property of Mr. Joseph Tanti.
4. A plot of land of the area of 7 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West by property of Zebbug Parish Church, on the East and West by property of Mr. Joseph Tanti; and on the South by property of Mr. Joseph Caruana.
5. A plot of land of the area of 3 Sieghan and 1 Kejlia, bounded on the East partly by Mill Street and partly by property of Mr. Joseph Caruana, and on the North, South and West by property of Mr. Joseph Caruana.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan L.D. 29/70, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
