

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by his Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Attard.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to \$3120. 0. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Attard:

1. A plot of land of the area of 36 square canes, bounded on the North-west and South-west by Saint Anthony Street, on the North by Old Railway Track, and on the East and South-East by property of Messrs. Dolphin Investments Limited.
2. A plot of land of the area of 196 square canes, bounded on the North by Old Railway Track, on the South-East by Birkkara Road, and on the South-West and West by property of Messrs. Dolphin Investments Limited.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 36/70, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
