

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND
PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Xaghra, Gozo.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for the purpose of road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £87. 5. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR--GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Xaghra, Gozo:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 93.5 square canes, bounded on the North by property of Mr. Rosino Bartolo, on the South by Government property, on the East by property of the heirs of the late Michael Tabone, and on the West by property of Mr. Francesco Rapa.
2. A plot of land of the area of 81 square canes, bounded on the North by property of Mrs. Antonia Fortelli, on the South by Government property, on the East by property of Reverend Canon Angelo Bartolo, and on the West partly by a lane in Victory Square and partly by property of Mr. Joseph Gatt.

The abovementioned two plots of land are shown as plots 2 and 3 on plan marked L.D. 178/69, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.

This declaration is to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 828 dated 10th October, 1969, in so far as plots 2 and 3 are concerned.
