

MEMORANDUM FOR THE CABINET BY

Visiting Master at St Mary Grammar School, Gozo

On the 16th June, 1969, Dr Gordon J.G. Munro was granted permission to reside permanently in Malta on condition that he would not engage in any employment whatsoever.

2. The Director of Education with the approval of the Minister of Education, Culture and Tourism is now recommending that Dr Munro be allowed to take up an appointment as Visiting Master to teach Physics and General Science at the St Mary Grammar School, Gozo, as no qualified applicants are willing to teach in Gozo.

3. On the 13th March, 1969, it was decided in Cabinet that permanent residents were not to be given work permits even if their services were required by a Government Department. Exceptions to this rule may be made only with Cabinet approval. Ministers are therefore invited to consider whether a licence ought to be issued to Dr Munro permitting him to act as Visiting Master at St Mary Grammar School, Gozo.
