

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of four plots of land at San Gwann.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government in connection with the construction of a Bypass; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £2,375. 0. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136, and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land  
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The following land at San Gwann:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 0.8 Kejliet, bounded on the North by a road, on the East and West by property of Mr. Gustav Vincenti A. & C.L., and on the South by property of Mr. John Mary Borg and others.
2. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 5 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property of Mr. Gustav Vincenti A. & C.L., on the East and West by property of Mr. John Mary Borg and others and on the South by property of Colonel Roger Strickland.
3. A plot of land of the area of 2 Sieghan and 3.7 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property of Mr. John Mary Borg and others, on the East and West by property of Colonel Roger Strickland and on the South by property in course of acquisition by Government.
4. A plot of land of the area of 3 Sieghan and 4 Kejliet, bounded on the West by property in course of acquisition by Government, on the North partly by a road and partly by property of Chevalier Dr. Louis Galea, M.D., on the East by a road and on the South by property of Dr. Louis Galea M.D.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 295/70 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
