

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of five plots of land at Attard.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £4,601.10.0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Attard:

1. A plot of land of the area of 2.9 Kejliet, bounded on the North, East and South by a public lane.
2. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 5.3 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property of Mr. John Agius and on the West and South-East by a public lane.
3. A plot of land of the area of 2.8 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property of Mr. Sydney Bernard Sanbrook, on the East by property of Mr. John Agius and on the South-East by a public lane.
4. A plot of land of the area of 3 Siegnan and 5.7 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West, North and South-East by a public lane.
5. A plot of land of the area of 2 Tumoli, 1 Siegh and 5.8 Kejliet, bounded on the North-East, South and North-West by a public road.

The above-mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 52/70, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
