

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached draft Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory imposition of an easement on a field at Dingli.

Since the easement consists in the laying of a main sewer pipe in a trench, including one covered manhole, it is within the meaning of a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the value of the compensation payable in connection with the above easement amounts to £3,4.8d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by way of the imposition thereon of the easement described hereunder.

Description of the land  
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The following easement at Dingli:

Easement consisting in the laying of a main sewer pipe in a trench 97 feet long by 11 feet deep by 3 feet wide, which includes one covered manhole, in a field of the area of 3 Sieghan and 4 Kejllet, bounded on the north partly by property of Mr. Salvu Zammit and partly by property of Mr. Carmelo Farrugia, on the west by property of Mrs. Maria Abela and on the South-west by property of Mr. Carmelo Abela.

The abovementioned easement is shown on plan marked L.D. 291/70, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
