

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of five plots of land at Victoria, Gozo.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to \$198.18.1d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land  
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The following land at Victoria, Gozo.

1. A plot of land of the area of 3 Sieghan and 1.03 Kejllet, bounded on the North and West by property of Doctor Alexander Depiro Gourgion LL.D., on the South by Xaghra Road and on the East by property of the heirs of the late Joseph Refalo.
2. A plot of land of the area of 1.54 Kejllet bounded on the north by property of the heirs of the late Joseph Refalo, on the South by Xaghra Road, on the East by a valley and on the West by property of Doctor Alexander Depiro Gourgion LL.D.
3. A plot of land of the area of 8.7 Kejllet bounded on the North by property of the heirs of the late Carlo Galea, on the South by Xaghra Road, on the East by property of Mr. Joseph Buttigieg and on the West by a valley.
4. A plot of land of the area of 6.86 Kejllet, bounded on the North and East by property of Mr. Joseph Buttigieg, on the South by Xaghra Road and on the West by property of the heirs of the late Carlo Galea.
5. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 1.55 Kejllet, bounded on the North and East by Mgarr Road, on the South by Archbishop Pace Street and on the West by property of Doctor Alexander Depiro Gourgion LL.D.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 261/70, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
