

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory imposition of an easement on a field at Rabat, Malta.

Since the easement consists in the laying of a sewer pipe in a trench, it is within the meaning of a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the value of the compensation payable in connection with the above easement amounts to £5. 6. 8.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by way of the imposition thereon of the easement described hereunder.

Description of the Land

The following easement at Rabat, Malta.

Easement consisting in the laying of a sewer pipe in a trench 160 feet long, 6 feet deep and 2 feet 6 inches wide in a field of the area of 1 Tumolo, 1 Siegh and 2 Kejllet, bounded on the South-East by property of the Cathedral Chapter of Mdina, on the North-East by Government property and on the West by a public road.

The abovementioned easement is shown on plan marked L.D. 241/70, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
