

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, (Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of four plots of land at Mellieha.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £844. 0. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR--GENERAL

I hereby declare that the un ermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 156) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute pruchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Mellieha:

1. A plot of land of the area of 311.5 square canes, bounded on the South by Mellieha-Mizieb Road, on the west by property of Mr. John Vella and on the North by property of Mr. Carmel Vella.
2. A plot of land of the area of 212.7 square canes, bounded on the South and South-west by Mellieha-Mizieb Road, on the East by property of Mr. Carmel Vella and on the North by property of Mr. John Vella.
3. A plot of land of the area of 41.7 square canes, including part of a rural structure thereon, bounded on the South and West by Mellieha-Mizieb Road, on the East-South-East by property of Mr. John Vella and on the North by property of Mr. Anthony Vella Borg.
4. A plot of land of the area of 133.8 square canes, including a rural structure thereon, bounded on the North-east by Mellieha-Mizieb Road, on the South-East by property of Mr. Joseph Borg and on the North-West by Government property.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 250/70, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
