

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of three plots of land at Xaghra, Gozo.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for the preservation of Calypso Cave; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £13. 15. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR--GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Kaghra, Gozo:

1. A plot of land of the area of 0.2 Kejliet, bounded on the East by property of the heirs of the late Angelo Portelli, on the North by property of Mrs. Antonia Buhagiar and on the South by Ramla Road.
2. A plot of land of the area of 1.8 Kejliet, bounded on the East by property of Mrs. Giuseppina Galea and others, on the North-North-East by property of the heirs of the late Angelo Portelli and on the South by property of Mrs. Antonia Buhagiar.
3. A plot of land of the area of 3.5 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property of Mrs. Giuseppina Galea and others, on the East by property of Mrs. Antonia Buhagiar and on the South by property of the heirs of the late Angelo Portelli.

The abovementioned plots of land are marked as plots Nos. 2A, 3A and 6A on plan marked L.D. 277A/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
