

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor General refers to the compulsory acquisition of three plots of land in the limits of Siggiewi and Qrendi.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government in connection with the construction of the Panoramic Road Section 2; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £1,603.0.0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land in the limits of Siggiewi and Grendi:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 3 Tumoli, 4 Sieghan and 3 Kejllet, including part of a rural structure thereon, in the limits of Siggiewi, bounded on the North-West and South-West by property of the Archiepiscopal Curia and on the South-East partly by property of the Archiepiscopal Curia and partly by a road.
2. A plot of land of the area of 2 Tumoli, 5 Sieghan and 3 Kejllet, including part of a rural structure thereon, in the limits of Grendi, bounded on the North-West by a road, on the North and South by property of the Archiepiscopal Curia and on the East by Government property.
3. A plot of land of the area of 2 Tumoli, bounded 4 Sieghan and 4 Kejllet, in the limits of Grendi, bounded on the West by a road, on the North-East and South-East by property of the Archiepiscopal Curia and on the East by property of Mr. Carmel Bugeja.

The above mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 273/70 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
