

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of five plots of land at Zurrieq.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government in connection with the Deutsche Welle Radio Relay Station at Nigret; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £761. 10. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land  
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The following land at Zurrieq:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 2 Tumoli, 5 Sieghan, 2.8 Kejliet, bounded on the North by property of Mr. Carmelo Farrugia, on the East by property of Mr. Michael Angelo Farrugia, on the South by a public passage.
2. A plot of land of the area of 4 Sieghan, 9.7 Kejliet, bounded on the South-East and South by a public passage and on the South-West and North-West by property of Mrs. Carmela Cachia.
3. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh, 7.3 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West and South by Government property and on the North-East by property of Mr. Francesco Cutajar.
4. A plot of land of the area of 3 Sieghan 8.9 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West and South-West by a public passage, on the South-East by Government property and on the North-East by property of Mrs. Francesca Camilleri.
5. A plot of land of the area of 2 Sieghan, 5.9 Kejliet, bounded on the North and South-West by Government property and on the East by the property of Mr. John Chetcuti.

The abovementioned plots of land are shown on a plan marked L.D. 138/71 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
