Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

L-Arkiyi! Nazzjonali ta' Malta

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of one plot of land at Luqa.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plot of land is required by the Government for the erection of an Electricity Substation; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £112. 0. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-- GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Luqa:

A Plot of land of the area of 11.2 square canes, including part of a rural structure thereon, and the air-space overlying the said plot of land from pavement level up to a height of 15 courses, bounded on the North and East by property of the Most Noble Baron Lino Testaferrata Bonnici and on the South by Tarxien Road.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 104/71, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
