

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Victoria, Gozo.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for the widening of By the Bastion Road, Victoria; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £108. 0. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR--GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Victoria, Gozo:

1. A plot of land of the area of 12 square canes, bounded on the North by property of Reverend Monsignor Edward Bondi, on the South and East by a public road and on the West by property of Mr. Francis Gauci.
2. A plot of land of the area of 1.5 square canes, bounded on the North and East by a public road, on the South by property of Mr. Francis Gauci and on the West by property of Reverend Monsignor Edward Bondi.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 27/71, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
