

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of nine plots of land at Gharghur.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for the formation of a new road; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £2,862. 0. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Gharghur:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 6.5 Kejllet, bounded on the South-West by a New Road, on the North-West and South-East by property of Gharghur Parish Church and on the North partly by property of Mr. Bartholomew Cuschieri and partly by property of Mrs. Angolina Attard.
2. A plot of land of the area of 1.1 Kejllet, bounded on the East by property of Mrs. Angolina Attard, on the South by property of Gharghur Parish Church and on the North-West by property of Mr. Bartholomew Cuschieri.
3. A Plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 6.7 Kejllet, bounded on the North-West and South-East by property of Mrs. Angolina Attard, on the South by property of Gharghur Parish Church, on the East by property of Mr. Salvatore Fenech and on the West by property of Mr. Bartholomew Cuschieri.
4. A plot of land of the area of 2.2 Kejllet, bounded on the West by property of Mrs. Angolina Attard, on the North by property of Mr. Victor Sammut and on the South-East by property of Mr. Salvatore Fenech.
5. Part of premises without number accessible from common entrance No. 7, Church Square, consisting of a room, a yard and part of a garden, of the area of 35 square canes, bounded on the North-West by property of Mr. Victor Sammut, on the South-East partly by property of Mrs. Angolina Attard and partly by property of Mr. Salvatore Fenech and on the East by property of Gharghur Parish Church.
6. Premises No. 5, Church Square.
7. Premises No. 6, Church Square.

8. Premises No. 3/4, Church Square.

9. Common entrance No. 7, Church Square, consisting of a covered passage and a small yard at ground floor level, of the area of 5.5 square canes, underlying in part the property of Mr. Carmelo Muscat, bounded on the North by Church Square, on the East partly by property of Mr. Bartholomew Cuschieri and partly by property of Mr. Carmelo Muscat and on the South by property of Mr. Victor Sammut.

The above mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 39/71, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
