

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of premises Nos. 69/70 St. Helen Street, B'Kara.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above premises are required by the Government for the development of the Parish Church at Birkirkara Area; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above premises amounts to £800. 0. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.
