

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of one (1) plot of land at Gudja.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plot of land is being acquired by the Government on behalf of Messrs Rocco Saliba and Angelo Mangion, the owners of the property abutting on the adjacent land, in order to enable them to form the street as required by law.

It is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £M207.37,5. The said Messrs Saliba and Mangion have already deposited this amount.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

DESCRIPTION OF THE LAND

The following land at Gudja:

A plot of land of the area of 41.45 square metres (182.0 square metres), bounded on the North partly by property of the Sisters of Charity and partly by property of Mr. Joseph Mifsud, on the East by property of Mr. Joseph Mifsud and on the South partly by property of Mr. Roque Saliba and partly by property of Mr. Angelo Mangion.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 107/72, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
