

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Agricultural Leases (Reletting) Act, 1967

The attached draft Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the termination of the lease of three (3) agricultural plots of land in the limits of Gudja.

This agricultural land, which belongs to the Government is required for a public purpose, namely for the extension of the Luqa Runway; consequently, the attached Declaration will be signed by His Excellency the Governor-General in accordance with the provisions of subsection (1) of section 20 of the Agricultural Leases (Reletting) Act, 1967.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land owned by Government is required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Agricultural Leases (Amendment) Act, 1967.

Description of the land

The following land in the limits of Gudja:

1. A plot of land of the area of approximately 6 Tumoli 4 Sieghan 4 Kejllet (7569 square metres) bounded on the North by property of Mr. Nazzareno Cassar, on the south-west by a public road and on the East by an alley and shown on Government Records as Rural Tenement No. 1485A.
2. A plot of land of the area of approximately 6 Tumoli 4 Sieghan 6 Kejllet (7607 square metres) bounded on the west by an alley, on the North by property of Mrs. Felicia Xuereb and on the south-east partly by property of Mrs. Rosina Mangion, partly by property of Mr. Bascal Vella and partly by property of St. Peter's Monastery of Mdina and shown on Government Records as Rural Tenement No. 1485.
3. A plot of land of the area of approximately 5 Tumoli 3 Sieghan 1 Kejla (6201 square metres) bounded on the North-east by property of Dr. Godfrey Randon, on the South by property of Mrs. Theresa Grech, on the North-west by property of the Parish Church of Tarxien and on the west by property administered by Notary Paul Pullicino and shown on Government Records as Rural Tenement No. 186.

The above-mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 124C/72 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
