

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of five plots of land at Ġħaxxaq.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for the purpose of road widening; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £117. 13. 11d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Ghaxaq:--

1. A plot of land of the area of 4.41 square canes, bounded on the North and West by property of Mr Vincenzo Borg and on the South by property of the Ghaxaq Parish Church.
2. A plot of land of the area of 2.99 square canes, bounded on the North by property of Mr Vincenzo Borg, on the East by property of Mr Charles Zammit and on the South-West by property of the Ghaxaq Parish Church.
3. A plot of land of the area of 9.55 square canes, bounded on the North and East by property of Mrs. Eva Cauchi and on the South by property of Saura Hospital.
4. A plot of land of the area of 6.24 square canes, bounded on the North-West by property of Mrs. Eva Cauchi, on the South West by property of Saura Hospital and on the South-East by Gebelin Alley.
5. A plot of land of the area of 9.18 square canes, including a rural structure, bounded on the North by Gebelin Alley, on the West by property of Saura Hospital and on the South by property of Mr. Joseph Schembri,

The above-mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 299/71, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
