

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of one plot of land at Siggiewi.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plot of land is required by the Government in connection with the widening of Dr. Nikola Zammit Street; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plot of land amounts £2184. 0. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR--GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purpose) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Siggiewi:--

A plot of land of the area of 72.2 square canes, including part of a farmhouse of the area of 33 square canes, bounded on the North--West by the property of Mrs Marianna Chetcuti on the South by Dr. Nikola Zammit Street and on the North--East by Notabile Road.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 202/71, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
