

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of one plot of land at Vittoriosa.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plot of land is required by the Government for the purpose of building a school; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £942. 10s. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

The following land at Vittoriosa.

A plot of land of the area of 6 Tmien, 1 Siegh, 7 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West partly by property of Vittoriosa Parish Church and partly by property of Mr. Joseph Farrugia, on the North-East by property of Mr. Joseph Farrugia and on the South-West by Government property.

The above mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 204/71, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
